New Fellowship Group – Men's Circle of Faith



The Fellowship committee is calling on all the men of the church to join us in a new fellowship group – **Men's Circle of Faith**. This group will meet on the second Saturday of each month, **beginning June 10th** in the Agnes Lea lounge. We will gather at 8:30am for a morning meal and fellowship followed by a short bible study, faith discussion and everyday application.

Pastor David Hill has graciously agreed to lead us in study and prayer by exploring the Life of Christ in context and through scripture. The first lesson will cover the Gospel of John – Chapter 1.

Deacons' Doings'

The Deacons thank everyone for their generosity and caring. The Barrel for items for Tracy Interfaith is filling up every month. There is a great need. Tracy Interfaith is helping almost 400 families a week. Most of them are very low income. The items for this month are “toilet paper & cleaning products”.

Also, thank you to the members who are signing up for flowers for the sanctuary and donating money to the Deacons Fund. Your support also goes to Tracy Community Connections Center, Tracy Volunteer Caregivers, and the Cpl Palmer Memorial Troop Support Program, and many other projects.

Session

The Session and the Board of Deacons met in joint session, which the Book of Order requires to be done at least once a year. The Deacons made the Session aware of several ideas that they are exploring.

Escrow for the sale of the property adjacent to the church is scheduled to close on June 6th. The process seems to be moving along without any problems.

Nancy Rusch presented Session with a summary of the conclusions reached by the *ad hoc* committee considering uses of the new site property. As indicated by the responses to the questionnaire the committee asked the congregation to complete, an overwhelming majority are in favor of selling the 2 parcels to the highest bidder and using some of the proceeds to refurbish the existing facility. The Session received the report and discharged the *ad hoc* committee with thanks for their work.

A report was made on the tax status of the new site property. When the parcels were acquired in 1997 and 1998, title was recorded in the name of the Presbytery of Stockton. Subsequently a community garden was established on a portion of the area and the County Assessor granted a partial welfare exemption of the assessed value. In 2022 the Presbytery of Stockton was dissolved and merged into the Presbytery of North Central California. With the dissolution of the Presbytery of Stockton, title was conveyed to the First Presbyterian Church Society of Tracy, and the Presbytery of Stockton's Organizational Clearance Certificate, that permitted the welfare exemption, was revoked. These actions resulted in reassessment of the property value and the loss of the welfare exemption. An application for an Organizational Clearance Certificate in the name of the church has been submitted to the State Board of Equalization but has not yet been received. When it is received, the County Assessor will reinstate the partial welfare exemption on parcel 1, where the community garden is located, but not on parcel 2. This reassessment has resulted in a supplemental tax bill of approximately \$6,200, due by the end of July 2023. The Session voted to appeal to the County Board of Supervisors the reassessment of property value based on the conveyance of title, because in accordance with Presbyterian polity, as stated in the Book of Order, all property is held in trust for the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), regardless of the name in which tile is recorded, so ownership of the property has not changed.
